

The Aazhaawe Ferry Boat (7751 Black River Rd., Virginia Beach)



The primary transport to and from Georgina Island from April to December, the Aazhaawe (to go across), can carry up to 18 vehicles on board and seat 50 on-foot passengers comfortably in the cabin space. To board the ferry, you must line your vehicle in one of the 3 designated areas - divided by yellow lines – (if these lines are full, you can continue to line up along the perimeter of the parking lot).

Wait for a staff person to direct you onto the boat. All passengers are asked to remain in the vehicle until all cars are loaded. It is important for the driver to stay with his/her vehicle until a staff person comes to collect payment (cash only). While aboard the Ferry please do not

climb on the railings or stand on the boarding ramps or attempt to climb the stairs up to the drivers cabin.

Re-enter your vehicle before the ferry boat reaches the docks and again wait for a staff person to guide you off the boat.

Vehicles can also be parked in the Virginia Beach Marina parking lot for those boarding on foot (cost extra).

Additional costs for the Ferry (Collected on board to the island. No return costs)

- Single car/truck – \$40.00 (boats and trailers extra \$40)
- Walk on - \$5.00
- Marina Parking - \$10

ARRIVING 30 MINUTES BEFORE THE SCHEDULED DEPARTURE WILL ENSURE YOU GET TO YOUR DESTINATION ON TIME. If you do miss your trip (and there are still cars in line) the ferry will usually come back right away – within 30 minutes.
